

ORDINANCE NO. 2007-122

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO FILE AN APPLICATION AND ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF ACQUIRING FUNDS THROUGH THE TRANSPORTATION ENHANCEMENT PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the Muddy Creek Trail, Phase II is an approximately 3950-foot stretch of multi-use trail along the Muddy Creek, connecting the existing path on Kings Mills Road near Pine Hill Lake Park to Heritage Oak Park; and

WHEREAS, the City of Mason recognizes the benefits to its citizens of providing a bicycle and pedestrian trail system; and

WHEREAS, the Muddy Creek Trail meets the objectives of the Mason Bicycle and Pedestrian Way Master Plan and the Comprehensive Plan and connects locally to a section of the Miami 2 Miami Connection;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, seven members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to apply for and, if awarded, enter into an agreement with the Ohio Department of Transportation to implement said program, and that the City Manager is authorized to sign said agreement.


Section 2. That the City of Mason hereby supports the Muddy Creek Trail application for funding through the Transportation Enhancement Program.


Section 3. That the Clerk is and she is hereby directed to certify a copy of this Ordinance to the Ohio Department of Transportation.

Section 4. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
