

ORDINANCE NO. 2007-14

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH TEC ENGINEERING, INC. FOR THE TRAFFIC SIGNAL SYSTEM OPERATIONS AND MAINTENANCE CONTRACT

WHEREAS, the City of Mason has previously contracted with TEC Engineering for the review and operation of the City's traffic signal system; and

WHEREAS, it is now necessary to enter into a yearly contract with TEC Engineering to operate and maintain the City's traffic signal system; and

WHEREAS, TEC Engineering has submitted a proposal to operate and maintain the City's traffic signal system for \$3,750 per month for one year.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, seven members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the City of Mason accepts the proposal of \$45,000, \$3,750 per month for one year, from TEC Engineering, Inc. for the operation and maintenance of the City's traffic signal system.

Section 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with TEC Engineering, Inc. in accordance with the terms of such proposal.

Section 3. That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to pay TEC Engineering, Inc. an amount not to exceed \$45,000 for the operation and maintenance of the City's traffic signal system.

Section 4. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
