

ORDINANCE NO. 2007-141

RENAMING BROWN BOULEVARD TO STRESS ENGINEERING WAY

WHEREAS, the partners of Stress Engineering have purchased the Parcels of 16221000310 and 16221000291 within the corporate city limits of Mason, Ohio, from the Home Builders Association that abut against Brown Boulevard; and

WHEREAS, Stress Engineering will now construct a 31,000 square foot, state-of-the-art manufacturing and laboratory facility on the two parcels of land to establish their growing regional office; and

WHEREAS, Stress Engineering has requested the renaming of approximately 600 feet of road recorded as Brown Boulevard in Plat book 79, page 67; and

WHEREAS, Brown Boulevard will be amended to Stress Engineering Way and filed as an amendment with the Warren County Recorder's Office.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, seven members elected thereto concurring:


Section 1. That the cul-de-sac roadway, which is 48 feet wide and approximately 600 feet long, and which borders Western Row Road to the south and is directly across from Cintas Boulevard, is hereby renamed Stress Engineering Way.


Section 2. That the City Manager is hereby directed to properly post the new street as Stress Engineering Way.
