

**ADOPTING THE WARREN COUNTY, OHIO MULTI-HAZARD
MITIGATION PLAN**

WHEREAS, the City of Mason recognizes the threat that natural hazards pose to people and property within our community; and

WHEREAS, undertaking hazard mitigation actions will reduce the potential for harm to people and property from future hazard occurrences; and

WHEREAS, an adopted Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan is required as a condition of future funding for mitigation projects under multiple FEMA pre- and post-disaster mitigation grant programs; and

WHEREAS, the City of Mason fully participated in the FEMA-prescribed mitigation planning process to prepare this Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Ohio Emergency Management Agency and Federal Emergency Management Agency officials have reviewed the “*Warren County, Ohio Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan*” and approved it contingent upon this official adoption of the participating governments and entities.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, seven members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the City of Mason adopts the “*Warren County, Ohio Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan*” as an official plan.


Section 2. That this Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
