

**OBJECTING TO THE APPLICATION FOR RENEWAL OF A LIQUOR PERMIT FOR VJ HOLDINGS LLC DBA KEVIN AND VINCE'S MASON PUB & PATIO AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, VJ Holdings LLC, dba Kevin & Vince's Mason Pub & Patio, has applied for the annual renewal of a D-5 and D-6 liquor permit a contained in Permit No. 9181085 to the Ohio Department of Liquor Control for the premises located at 753 Reading Road, Suite B, Mason, Ohio 45040; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Mason and the City of Mason Police Department object to the application for the above permit for the reasons set forth in Section 1 of this Resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, five members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. The City of Mason hereby objects to the application of VJ Holdings LLC, dba Kevin & Vince's Mason Pub & Patio, 753 Reading Road, Suite B, Mason, Ohio 45040, for renewal of a D-5 and D-6 liquor permit to be located at that address as contained in Permit No. 9181085 to the Ohio Department of Liquor Control, for the following reasons:

A. The Applicant has operated the liquor permit business in a manner that demonstrates a disregard for the laws, regulations, or local ordinances of this state.

B. The permit premises is so located with respect to the neighborhood that substantial interference with public decency, sobriety, peace, or good order would result from the renewal of the permit and operation under it by the Applicant.

Section 2. That the City of Mason hereby requests a hearing on the above application be held in Lebanon, Warren County, Ohio, the county seat in the county in which the business is operated.

Section 3. That the statement of the Law Director, as required by R.C. 4303.271, is attached hereto as Exhibit A, and incorporated herein by reference.

Section 4. That the Law Director or any of his assistants shall be designated to represent the City of Mason at any hearings pertaining to this application.


Section 5. That the Clerk of Council is hereby authorized and directed to forward two (2) certified copies of this Resolution by registered or certified mail to the Director, Ohio Department of Liquor Control.

Section 6. That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare and shall be effective immediately upon its passage. The reason for said declaration of emergency is the need to submit the objections at the earliest possible date to initiate the hearing process.
