

ORDINANCE NO. 2008 - 119

**AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH ISS FACILITY SERVICES FOR THE MUNICIPAL CENTER AND THE WATER RECLAMATION PLANT'S ADMINISTRATIVE BUILDING JANITORIAL CLEANING SERVICES**

WHEREAS, bids have been received for the janitorial cleaning service of the Mason Municipal Center and Water Reclamation Plant's Administrative Building; and

WHEREAS, ISS Facility Services is the lowest and best bidder with a bid of \$104,922 for said janitorial cleaning service.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, six members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the bid of ISS Facility Services in the amount of \$104,922 for the 1<sup>st</sup> year, optional \$108,070 for the 2<sup>nd</sup> year, and optional \$111,312 for the 3<sup>rd</sup> year, is hereby accepted as the lowest and best bid for the janitorial cleaning service of the Mason Municipal Center and Water Reclamation Plant's Administrative Building.

Section 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with ISS Facility Services for the janitorial cleaning service of the Mason Municipal Center and Water Reclamation Plant's Administrative Building according to the specifications set forth by the City.


Section 3. That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to pay said ISS Facility Services an amount not to exceed \$104,922 for the 1<sup>st</sup> year, an optional \$108,070 for the 2<sup>nd</sup> year, an optional \$111,312 for the 3<sup>rd</sup> year, for said janitorial cleaning services.

Section 4. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
