

ORDINANCE NO. 2008 - 36

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH ENVIRONMENTAL ENGINEERING SERVICE, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$17,600, FOR DESIGN OF REPLACEMENT SANITARY SEWERS IN OLYMPIA DRIVE, WESTERN ROW ROAD, TRADEWIND DRIVE, AND QUINN PARK

WHEREAS, inspections by the City's Public Utilities Department have determined that a portion of the existing sanitary sewer system in Olympia Drive is in danger of collapse and therefore needing replacement; and

WHEREAS, adjoining portions of the sanitary sewer system immediately upstream and downstream of Olympia Drive are in deteriorated condition; and

WHEREAS, Environmental Engineering Service (EES), has proposed to provide the City of Mason with design of replacement sewers in the affected portions of Olympia Drive, Western Row Road, Tradewind Drive, and Quinn Park in the total amount of \$17,600.00; and

WHEREAS, EES is qualified to perform the specified services; and

WHEREAS, the City has reviewed the proposed services and fees submitted by EES and finds them to be cost effective for the desired results to the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, six members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the proposal for Design of Olympia Drive Replacement Sewers by EES, in the amount of \$17,600.00, is hereby accepted.

Section 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with EES for Design of Olympia Drive Replacement Sewers.

Section 3. That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to pay EES, an amount not to exceed \$17,600.00 for said replacement sanitary sewer design.

Section 4. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
