LOGO UPDATE

Jennifer Mayhall with Rocket Science + Design, addressed Council and presented several potential logo slogans. Council discussed the suggestions and narrowed the selections down to two. Jennifer reported the next step will be to provide artwork with the logos and present them to Council.

COMMUNITY CENTER UPDATE


Rick Tripp with MSA & Associates addressed Council and explained the expansion options that have been discussed with the Community Center Committee. Vice Mayor Beck stated the status of this project is at the point that Council must now decide on which option they want to pursue.

Eric Hansen presented a financial analysis of the current status of the center, conservative projections once the remodeling is complete and target projections. A general discussion took place among Councilmembers on what is the City's ultimate goal and clarification on the type of product we are trying to offer the residents of Mason. The benefits of partnering with TriHealth and the risk factors for the City were discussed. Eric noted the risk for the City is the debt service for the expansion. Vice Mayor Beck stated the recommendation from the Committee is to proceed with the larger remodeling project resulting in more square footage.

After much discussion, a consensus was reached and Council elected to proceed with the full expansion.
