

ORDINANCE NO. 2009-100

APPOINTING AN INTERIM CITY PROSECUTOR AND ESTABLISHING THE COMPENSATION FOR PROSECUTION SERVICES FOR THE PERIOD BEGINNING SEPTEMBER 4, 2009 AND ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2009 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, six members elected thereto concurring:


Section 1. That Bethany Bennett is hereby appointed as the Interim Prosecutor for the Mason Municipal Court for the period beginning September 4, 2009 and ending December 31, 2009.

Section 2. That said Interim Prosecutor shall receive the same compensation, including benefits, as were previously approved by this Council for Robert Peeler in his capacity as City Prosecutor.

Section 3. That said Interim Prosecutor, or her designated Assistant, shall perform the following duties: prosecute all matters in Mason Municipal Court, including tax matters and Building Code matters, as well as all other criminal and traffic matters, advise and counsel members of the City of Mason Police Department regarding these prosecutions, and handle all other matters that may arise related to prosecutions.


Section 4. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare and shall be effective retroactively to September 4, 2009. The reason for said declaration of emergency is the need to maintain prosecutorial services for Mason Municipal Court.
