

ORDINANCE NO. 2009 - 104

**AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH PHILLIPS SUPPLY COMPANY IN THE AMOUNT OF \$90,847.80 FOR CITYWIDE JANITORIAL SUPPLIES**

WHEREAS, bids were received for a three (3) year contract to provide Citywide Janitorial Supplies; and

WHEREAS, Phillips Supply Company was the lowest and best bidder with a bid of \$90,847.80 for the three (3) year contract to provide Citywide Janitorial Supplies.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, seven members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the bid of Phillips Supply Company, in the amount of \$90,847.80, is hereby accepted as the lowest and best bid for the three (3) year contract to provide Citywide Janitorial Supplies.

Section 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Phillips Supply Company for Citywide Janitorial Supplies, according to the specifications set forth by the City.


Section 3. That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to pay Phillips Supply Company a total amount not to exceed \$90,847.80 for Citywide Janitorial Supplies.

Section 4. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
