

ORDINANCE NO. 2009 - 23

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH E-Z-GO COMPANY FOR THE PURCHASE OF 100 2008 E-Z-GO TXT PDS GOLF CARTS INCLUDING THE TRADE-IN OF 125 2003 OBSOLETE GOLF CARTS

WHEREAS, bids were solicited for the purchase of 2008 model year golf carts; and
WHEREAS, Section 721.15 of the Ohio Revised Code provides that when the legislative authority determines that certain equipment is obsolete and no longer need for a public purpose, and the municipality is in need of the same type of equipment, the purchase of the new equipment and trade-in of the obsolete equipment may be consummated in a single contract; and

WHEREAS, E-Z Go Company has submitted the lowest and best bid.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, seven members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That 125 2003 model year golf carts owned by the City of Mason are hereby declared to be obsolete and no longer necessary for any public purpose.

Section 2. That it is in the best interest of the City of Mason to simultaneously purchase new golf carts and trade-in obsolete golf carts.

Section 3. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with E-Z-Go Company for the purchase of 100 2008 model year E-Z-Go TXT PDS golf carts, including the trade-in of 125 obsolete 2003 model year golf carts.

Section 4. That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to pay E-Z-Go Company the sum of \$103,750.00 for said golf carts.

Section 5. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
