

ORDINANCE NO. 2009-24

AMENDING THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF MASON TO AMEND SECTION 351.15 REGARDING PARKING RESTRICTIONS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Section 351.15 of the Mason Codified Ordinance currently regulates parking on the Municipal parking lot; and

WHEREAS, Council has determined that it is in the best interest of the City of Mason to clarify that those regulations extend to all Municipally owned and operated parking areas.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, five, members concurring:

Section 1. That Section 351.15 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Mason, Ohio is hereby amended as set forth herein:


351.15 PARKING TIME LIMIT ON MUNICIPAL PARKING LOTS.

(a) No person shall park and let remain parked a motor vehicle of any type, whether operative or inoperative, on any City owned or operated parking lot or temporary parking area in violation of any posted parking restrictions unless otherwise authorized by the City Manager.

(b) In addition to any other penalties provided by law, any vehicle parked in violation of this section shall be considered to constitute a hazard or obstruction to the normal movement of traffic and shall be subject to removal and impounding pursuant to section 303.08.

Section 2. That this Ordinance is hereby declared an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and general welfare and shall be effective immediately upon its passage. The reason for said declaration of emergency is the need to immediately regulate parking on City property and to preserve and protect the safety of drivers and pedestrians in these areas.
