

**ORDINANCE NO. 2009 - 33**

**AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2007-13 TO ESTABLISH NEW RATES  
FOR THE LOU EVES MUNICIPAL SWIMMING POOL LOCATED AT  
CORWIN M. NIXON PARK**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, six members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. 2007-13 is hereby amended to establish the following rates for daily and season passes for use of the Lou Eves Municipal Swimming Pool at the Corwin M. Nixon Park for the 2009, effective May 1, 2009, and 2010 season, effective January 1, 2010, and a COLA increase, which will be decided by Council, will become effective for each year beginning on January 1, 2011.

<b>2009 DAILY RATES:</b>	<u>RESIDENTS</u>	<u>NONRESIDENTS</u>
Adults (17+ years)	\$4.75	\$7.50
Child/Senior/Disabled	\$3.75	\$6.25

<b>2010 DAILY RATES:</b>	<u>RESIDENTS</u>	<u>NONRESIDENTS</u>
Adults (17+ years)	\$5.00	\$8.00
Child/Senior/Disabled	\$4.00	\$6.75

There will be a 50% reduction in the daily rate after 5:00 p.m.

<b>2009 SEASON PASSES:</b>	<u>RESIDENTS</u>	<u>CORPORATE</u>	<u>NONRESIDENTS</u>
Adults (17+ years)	\$67.00	\$99.00	\$145.00
Child/Senior/Disabled	\$41.00	\$60.00	\$88.00
Family (household)	\$118.00	\$179.00	\$297.00

Each Season Pass Holder shall have the right to purchase 10 daily admissions for the season at a cost of \$23.00 in 2009.

<b>2010 SEASON PASSES:</b>	<u>RESIDENTS</u>	<u>CORPORATE</u>	<u>NONRESIDENTS</u>
Adults (17+ years)	\$71.00	\$104.00	\$153.00
Child/Senior/Disabled	\$44.00	\$63.00	\$93.00
Family (household)	\$124.00	\$188.00	\$312.00

Each Season Pass Holder shall have the right to purchase 10 daily admissions for the season at a cost of \$25.00 in 2010.

Mason Community Center Members may receive a 20% discount on Season Passes. Mason Community Center VIP Members may receive a 50% discount on Season Passes. This is for Season Passes as the same defined category, i.e., a Community Center Family Pass Holder can purchase only the Pool Family Pass to receive the discount.

After July 15<sup>th</sup>, Season Passes may be offered at a 50% discount of current rates. They may not be applied with other discounts offered.

Section 2. The following definitions shall apply to the above rates:  
Resident shall be defined as any person who lives in the City of Mason.

Senior shall be defined as any adult 60 years of age and older.

Youth shall be defined as any child 4 to 16 years of age.


Adult shall be defined as any person 17 years of age and older.

Family is defined as a married couple or single adult, and any children residing in the same household and claimed on their most recent federal income tax return.

Corporate applies to any individual or the family or a head of household or spouse, who works fulltime within the City of Mason corporate limits.

Section 3. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
