

ORDINANCE NO. 2009 - 41

AMENDING SECTION 165.03(a) OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF MASON, OHIO, REGARDING HOLIDAYS TO INCLUDE CHRISTMAS EVE DAY

WHEREAS, Section 165.03(a) currently does not include Christmas Eve Day on the list of holidays; and

WHEREAS, Council has determined that it is in the best interest of the City to include Christmas Eve Day in the list of City holidays.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, seven members elected thereto concurring:


Section 1. That Section 165.03(a) of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Mason, Ohio, is hereby amended to read as provided in Exhibit "A", attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

Section 2. That the remaining provisions of Section 165.03 shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 3. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.



EXHIBIT "A"

165.03 HOLIDAYS.

(a) The following shall constitute legal holidays for all regular full-time employees of the City.

New Year's Day; President's Day; Good Friday; Memorial Day; Independence Day; Labor Day; Thanksgiving Day; Day after Thanksgiving; Christmas Eve Day; Christmas Day.

When any of the above holidays fall on Saturday, they will be observed on the preceding Friday. When any of the above holidays fall on Sunday, they will be observed on the following Monday. The City Manager is authorized to reconcile any conflicts with the above or to make appropriate substitutions.

- (1) Regular full-time employees shall receive a full day's pay for each holiday set forth above.
- (2) Regular part-time employees shall receive a prorated number of hours of pay relative to a full-time employee's eight hours of pay by dividing the number of hours that they have been hired to work each week by forty (40) hours. The percentage derived equals the prorated amount.
- (3) Regular part-time Recreation employees shall be paid time and one half for hours worked on the actual holiday.
