

ORDINANCE NO. 2009 - 65

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH DEBRA-KUEMPEL MECHANICAL-ELECTRICAL, IN THE AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$1,392,000.00 FOR THE ELECTRICAL FOR THE MASON COMMUNITY CENTER ADDITION AND ALTERATIONS PROJECT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, bids were received for the Electrical for the Mason Community Center Addition and Alterations Project; and

WHEREAS, DeBra-Kuempel Mechanical-Electrical was the lowest and best bidder with a total bid of \$1,392,000.00 for the Electrical for the Mason Community Center Addition and Alterations Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, seven members elected thereto concurring:


Section 1. That the total bid of DeBra-Kuempel Mechanical-Electrical in the amount of \$1,392,000.00 is hereby accepted as the lowest and best bid for the Electrical for the Mason Community Center Addition and Alterations Project.

Section 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with DeBra-Kuempel Mechanical-Electrical for the Electrical for the Mason Community Center Addition and Alterations Project according to the specifications set forth by the City.

Section 3. That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to pay DeBra-Kuempel Mechanical-Electrical an amount not to exceed \$1,392,000.00 for the Electrical for the Mason Community Center Addition and Alterations Project.

Section 4. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare and shall be effective immediately upon its passage. The reason for said declaration of emergency is the need to commence construction at the earliest possible date to accomplish the scheduled completion date.
