

ORDINANCE NO. 2009 - 81

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH CTL ENGINEERING, INC., IN THE AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$56,300.00, FOR TESTING AND INSPECTION SERVICES FOR THE MASON COMMUNITY CENTER ADDITION AND ALTERATIONS PROJECT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, proposals were received for the Testing and Inspection services for the Mason Community Center Addition and Alterations Project; and

WHEREAS, CTL Engineering, Inc., was the best professional services proposal with a total estimate of \$56,300.00 for the Testing and Inspection services for the Mason Community Center Addition and Alterations Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, seven members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the total bid of CTL Engineering, Inc., in the amount of \$56,300.00, is hereby accepted as the lowest and best proposal for the Testing and Inspection services for the Mason Community Center Addition and Alterations Project.

Section 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with CTL Engineering, Inc., for the Testing and Inspection services for the Mason Community Center Addition and Alterations Project according to the specifications set forth by the City.


Section 3. That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to pay CTL Engineering, Inc., an amount not to exceed \$56,300.00 for the Testing and Inspection services for the Mason Community Center Addition and Alterations Project.

Section 4. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare and shall be effective immediately upon its passage. The reason for said declaration of emergency is the need to commence Testing and Inspection services at the earliest possible date to accomplish the scheduled completion date.
