

ORDINANCE NO. 2009 - 86

**AUTHORIZING A PAYMENT TO GREATER CINCINNATI  
WATERWORKS FOR A COMMERCIAL METER PERMIT FEE, IN  
THE AMOUNT OF \$25,431.00, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, as part of the Mason Community Center Expansion Project, it will be necessary to obtain a permit for a 3" commercial water meter.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, seven members elected thereto concurring:


Section 1. That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to pay Greater Cincinnati Waterworks an amount not to exceed \$25,431.00 for a 3" commercial meter permit fee.

Section 2. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare and shall be effective immediately upon its passage. The reason for said declaration of emergency is the need to install a water meter pit at the earliest possible date in order to avoid construction delays for the Community Center Expansion Project.
