COMMENDING ROBERT PEELER FOR HIS OUTSTANDING DEDICATION AND SERVICE TO THE CITY OF MASON, OHIO

WHEREAS, Robert Peeler has given dedicated service to the City of Mason, Ohio, since January 1, 1984; and

WHEREAS, in addition to his service as Mason City Prosecutor, Robert Peeler is a veteran of the United States Army.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT UNANIMOUSLY RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio:

Section 1. That Robert Peeler is hereby given the commendation of the Council of the City of Mason for his outstanding and distinguished service to said City.
