

RESOLUTION 2009 - 4

AUTHORIZING A POLICE DEPARTMENT STAFFING REORGANIZATION PLAN

WHEREAS, it is the will of the Council that the administration restructure various positions in the Police Department; and

WHEREAS, it is the will of the Council that the administration create a new command structure, with new titles and responsibilities commensurate with rank; and

WHEREAS, it is the will of Council that the administration includes, within its consideration, positions for future expansion of department services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, seven members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That City Manager shall present to the Council, at such time that existing positions are to be retitled, that newly created positions are to be filled, an ordinance changing the titles of existing positions, creating new positions, and/or authorizing an increase in the complement of personnel, and/or restructuring the Police Department, consistent with the following expressed intent:

- A. That there shall be, at such time as the City Manager deems the need exists, another Assistant Chief position.
- B. That a new supervisory level of the department shall be established, at such time as the City Manager deems appropriate.
- C. That there shall be established administrative supervisors within the civilian ranks of the Department, at such time as the City Manager deems appropriate.
- D. That the previously created Officer-in-Charge structure, which was meant to be temporary, shall be replaced with a permanent supervisory rank structure.
- E. That the Department shall be comprised of the following divisions: administrative, patrol, investigations, and support.


Section 2. That it is not the intent of this Resolution to change the bargaining unit status, as may be permitted by Chapter 4117 of the Ohio Revised Code, of any position in the Police Department, except as may be authorized by Chapter 4117 of the Ohio Revised Code.


Section 3. That this Resolution is not intended to authorize, create or fund any position of employment.

Section 4. That this Resolution shall be in force and become effective from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
