

ORDINANCE NO. 2010 - 114

**AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A REIMBURSEMENT AGREEMENT WITH JEFFREY SPATZ FOR A SANITARY SEWER CROSSING OF MASON-MONTGOMERY ROAD AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the City of Mason intends to construct a sanitary sewer crossing of Mason-Montgomery Road to provide access to sanitary sewerage for presently unsewered City residents on the west side of Mason-Montgomery Road; and

WHEREAS, Jeffrey Spatz, who owns property on the west side of Mason-Montgomery Road and intends to build a residence there, desires to connect to the City sanitary sewer system; and

WHEREAS, Jeffrey Spatz has offered to reimburse the City for a portion of said sanitary sewer crossing in the amount of \$20,000.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, seven members elected thereto concurring:


Section 1. That the City Manager is authorized to enter into a reimbursement agreement with Jeffrey Spatz, under which Mr. Spatz will transmit the sum of \$20,000.00 to the City upon completion of the sanitary sewer crossing of Mason-Montgomery Road, pursuant to the terms of the reimbursement agreement attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein by reference.

Section 2. That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to accept from Mr. Spatz the amount of \$20,000.00 pursuant to the terms of the agreement attached hereto, and deposit said amount in the City Sewer Fund.

Section 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare and shall be effective immediately upon its passage. The reason for said declaration of emergency is the need execute the agreement at the earliest possible date.
