

ORDINANCE NO. 2010 - 115

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH BEAVER CREEK HYDROLOGY, LLC, FOR DESIGN OF MUDDY CREEK RESTORATION, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$70,200.00, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, certain reaches of Muddy Creek within the City of Mason are subject to severe erosion and are in need of restoration in order to preserve the natural quality of the stream; and

WHEREAS, the City of Mason has applied for and received a 319 Grant in the total amount of \$258,000.00 for design and construction of stream restoration projects in two reaches of Muddy Creek in the vicinity of St. Susanna's Church and of the Four Seasons Apartment Complex; and

WHEREAS, the City has requested design proposals from a number of qualified firms; and

WHEREAS, the proposal submitted by Beaver Creek Hydrology, LLC, has been determined to be the most responsive to the project requirements and at a competitive price.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, seven members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the City Manager is authorized to enter into an agreement with Beaver Creek Hydrology, LLC, in an amount not to exceed \$70,200.00, pursuant to the terms of the proposal attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein by reference.


Section 2. That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to pay an amount not to exceed \$70,200.00 pursuant to the terms of the agreement attached hereto.

Section 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare and shall be effective immediately upon its passage. The reason for said declaration of emergency is the need execute the agreement at the earliest possible date.
