

ORDINANCE NO. 2010 - 119

**AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ACCEPT THE FEDERAL SECURE OUR SCHOOLS GRANT #2010CKWX0710 IN THE AMOUNT OF \$22,295 AND IN TURN FORWARD THOSE FUNDS TO THE MASON CITY SCHOOLS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

**WHEREAS**, The City of Mason Police Department and the Mason City schools jointly applied for a Secure Our Schools Grant from the federal government in the amount of \$22,295 to assist in the purchase of a portable radio system to be used within the schools; and

**WHEREAS**, the Grant in the amount of \$22,295 was awarded on September 29, 2010; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mason City Schools will own and be responsible for the purchase, installation, and maintenance of the system.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, six members elected thereto concurring:


Section 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to accept the grant award of \$22,295.

Section 2. That the City Manager is further authorized to have the Finance Director forward funds in the amount of \$22,295 to the Mason City Schools once the system has been purchased.

Section 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare, and shall be effective immediately upon passage. The reason for said declaration of emergency is the need to accept the grant at the earliest possible date in order to improve public safety.
