

ORDINANCE NO. 2010 – 89

AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2006-20 ESTABLISHING THE POSITIONS AND RATES OF COMPENSATION FOR EMPLOYEES OF THE MASON MUNICIPAL COURT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Chapter 1901 of the Ohio Revised Code confers upon a municipal court the authority to appoint employees to certain court positions; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 1901 of the Ohio Revised Code confers upon the municipal court the authority to determine the compensation of bailiffs, deputy bailiffs, and deputy clerks; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 1901 of the Ohio Revised Code confers upon the legislative authority of the municipality in which a municipal court sets the authority to determine the reasonable compensation of all other necessary employees; and

WHEREAS, the judge of the Mason Municipal Court has determined certain positions to be necessary for the effective administration of the Mason Municipal Court.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, six members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That this Ordinance shall establish the positions and rates of compensation for employees of the Mason Municipal Court.


Section 2. That this Ordinance shall be known as “The Municipal Court Salary Ordinance.”


Section 3. That the positions and rates of compensation established by this Ordinance are set out in Exhibit “A” which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

Section 4. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare and shall be effective August 1, 2010. The reason for said emergency is the need to establish the positions and rates of compensation for employees of the Mason Municipal Court as of August 1, 2010, and for the effective administration of the Mason Municipal Court.
