

ORDINANCE NO. 2010 - 9

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A TWO-YEAR CONTRACT WITH TEC ENGINEERING, INC., TO OPERATE AND MAINTAIN THE CITY'S TRAFFIC SIGNAL SYSTEM, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$46,500.00 FOR YEAR ONE, AND \$48,000.00 FOR YEAR TWO

WHEREAS, the City of Mason previously contracted with TEC Engineering, Inc., for a two-year contract to operate and maintain efficient operation of the City's traffic signal system; and

WHEREAS, it is now necessary to enter into a new two-year contract with TEC Engineering, Inc., to operate and maintain the City's traffic signal system; and

WHEREAS, TEC Engineering, Inc., has submitted a proposal to operate and maintain the City's traffic signal system for \$3,875.00 per month for the first year, and \$4,000.00 per month for the second year.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, seven members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the City of Mason accepts the proposal of \$46,500.00, at \$3,875.00 per month for year one, and \$48,000.00, at \$4,000.00 per month for year two, from TEC Engineering, Inc., for the operation and maintenance of the City's traffic signal system.

Section 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with TEC Engineering, Inc., in accordance with the terms of such proposal.

Section 3. That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to pay TEC Engineering, Inc., an amount not to exceed \$3,875.00 per month for year one, and \$4,000.00 per month for year two, for the operation and maintenance of the City's traffic signal system.

Section 4. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
