

ORDINANCE NO. 2011 - 41

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH CHARLES H. HAMILTON COMPANY FOR EMERGENCY REPAIR TO THE WESTERN ROW LIFT STATION FORCE MAIN, FOR NOT TO EXCEED AMOUNT OF \$37,000.00, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City of Mason on March 8, 2011, discovered a break in the Western Row Lift Station force main on the north side of Western Row, just west of I-71; and

WHEREAS, it was imperative that repair be made to the force main at the earliest possible time in order to protect public health; and

WHEREAS, Charles H. Hamilton Co. was contacted by City staff and asked to furnish prices for labor, equipment, and materials to complete the repair on an emergency basis; and

WHEREAS, Charles H. Hamilton Co. was authorized to proceed with the emergency repair and successfully repaired on March 10, 2011 with final repair beginning April 11, 2011.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, seven members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the City of Mason finds acceptable and in accordance with information supplied in advance of the repair by Charles H. Hamilton Co. the summary of actual labor, equipment, and material costs incurred by Charles H. Hamilton Co. in the amount not to exceed \$37,000.00.


Section 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Charles H. Hamilton Co. for the emergency repair made to the Western Row Lift Station force main between March 8 and March 10, 2011 and April 11 thru April 12, 2011.


Section 3. That the Finance Director is authorized to pay Charles H. Hamilton Co. the not to exceed amount of \$37,000.00 upon execution of a contract between the City of Mason and Charles H. Hamilton Co.

Section 4. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare and shall be effective immediately upon its passage. The reason for said declaration of emergency is the need to execute the contract at the earliest possible date.
