

ORDINANCE NO. 2011 - 89

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH DIGGIT EXCAVATING, INC. FOR EVERYBODY'S FARM IMPROVEMENT PROJECT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, bids were received for the Everybody's Farm Improvement Project; and
WHEREAS, Diggit Excavating, Inc. was the lowest and best bidder with a bid of \$1,309,125.56 for said Everybody's Farm Improvement Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, five members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the bid of the Diggit Excavating, Inc. in the amount of \$1,309,125.56 is hereby accepted as the lowest and best bid for the Everybody's Farm Improvement Project.


Section 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with the Diggit Excavating, Inc. for the Everybody's Farm Improvement Project, according to the specifications set forth by the City.


Section 3. That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to pay said Diggit Excavating, Inc. an amount not to exceed \$1,309,125.56 for the Everybody's Farm Improvement Project.

Section 4. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare and shall be effective immediately upon its passage. The reason for said declaration of emergency is the need to implement the completion of said public improvement.
