

ORDINANCE NO. 2011 - 93

**AUTHORIZING CONTINUED PARTICIPATION IN THE AMENDED  
AND RESTATED WARREN COUNTY DRUG TASK FORCE  
COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS CONTRACT**

WHEREAS, in recognition of the need for an aggressive endeavor in combating drug trafficking in the Warren County area, the Prosecuting Attorney and Sheriff of Warren County, the Cities of Springboro, Franklin, Lebanon, Mason and Clearcreek Township established a task force to combine the capabilities and resources of all governmental bodies aforementioned in a cooperative drug-fighting effort; and

WHEREAS, the City of Mason has passed Ordinance No. 93-4 and Ordinance No. 2005-36 authorizing the City's continued participation in and support of the Warren County Drug Task Force; and


WHEREAS, the City of Mason wishes to continue to participate in and support the Warren County Drug Task Force under the terms of the Amended and Restated Warren County Drug Task Force Council of Governments Contract, attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein by reference.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, five members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into the Amended and Restated Warren County Drug Task Force Council of Governments Contract, providing for the continued combination of the capabilities and resources of Cities of Franklin, Springboro, Lebanon, Wilmington, Mason, and Clearcreek Township, Hamilton Township, the Villages of Waynesville and Maineville, and Warren and Clinton Counties, in a cooperative drug-fighting effort, under the terms contained in said Contract, attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein by reference.

Section 2. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
