

RESOLUTION NO. 2011 - 15

PROCLAIMING THE WEEK OF OCTOBER 9 – 15, 2011
AS NATIONAL FIRE PREVENTION WEEK

WHEREAS, public safety is a top priority in the City of Mason; and

WHEREAS, the City of Mason is committed to ensuring the safety and security of all those living in and visiting our City; and

WHEREAS, fire is a serious public safety concern both locally and nationally, and homes are the locations where people are at greatest risk from fire; and

WHEREAS, the nonprofit National Fire Protection Association (NFPA) has documented through its research, even as most other causes of home fires have steadily declined a significant increase in home cooking fires; and

WHEREAS, the City of Mason's first responders are dedicated to reducing the occurrence of home fires and home fire injuries through prevention and protection education; and

WHEREAS, the City of Mason's residents are responsive to public education measures and are able to take personal steps to increase their safety from fire; and

WHEREAS, using proper care with cooking appliances will have a positive effect on the home fire problem; each cooking fire that is prevented in the City of Mason is an opportunity to prevent painful injury and costly property damage; and

WHEREAS, having and practicing a home escape plan is an important part of helping a family to escape the dangers of fire; and

WHEREAS, the 2011 Fire Prevention Week theme, "Protect Your Family From Fire", effectively serves to remind us all of the simple actions we can take to stay safer from fire during Fire Prevention Week and year-round.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, five members elected thereto concurring:
