

ORDINANCE NO. 2012 – 32

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO INCREASE THE AMOUNT OF REIMBURSEMENT TO WARREN COUNTY FOR UTILITY RELOCATION RELATED TO THE BETHANY ROAD WIDENING PROJECT

WHEREAS, Council has previously adopted Ordinance 2011-49, which authorized the City Manager to enter into a Utility Relocation Reimbursement Agreement with Warren County related to the Bethany Road Widening Project, and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 2011-49 provided for a total reimbursement to Warren County under the Reimbursement Agreement not to exceed \$240,000.00, based on preliminary estimates of construction cost furnished by Warren County, and

WHEREAS, actual construction of the Bethany Road Widening Project by the County's contractor in 2011 and 2012 required additional relocation of City-owned force mains at a cost estimated by Warren County to be approximately \$60,000.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, six members elected thereto concurring:


Section 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute an internal purchase order not to exceed \$60,000.00 to cover approved additional reimbursable expenditures for utility relocations submitted by Warren County.


Section 2. That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to reimburse Warren County an additional amount not to exceed \$60,000.00 for said utility relocations.

Section 3. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
