

ORDINANCE NO. 2012 - 43

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE LOW AND BEST BID FOR THE SOUTHWEST MASON AREA SANITARY SEWER IMPROVEMENT PROJECT FROM MILLER PIPELINE, LLC AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE CONTRACT DOCUMENTS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City of Mason received on June 7, 2012 a total of five (5) competitive bids for construction of the Southwest Mason Area Sanitary Sewer Improvement Project; and

WHEREAS, tabulation and analysis of the bids received on June 7, 2012 indicates that the lowest and best bid was provided by Miller Pipeline, LLC in the total amount of \$387,299.00

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, seven members thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the contract for the Southwest Mason Area Sanitary Sewer Improvement Project is awarded to Miller Pipeline, LLC at the bid amount of \$387,299.00.

Section 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to execute contract documents with Miller Pipeline, LLC on behalf of the City of Mason.


Section 3. That the Finance Director is authorized to make payment to Miller Pipeline, LLC on the basis of approved payment applications, up to the contract amount of \$387,299.00.

Section 4. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of public health, safety, and general welfare and shall be effective immediately upon its passage. The reason for said declaration of emergency is the need to complete construction and improve sewer service in the areas of Manhasset Village and Olympia Fields subdivisions at the earliest possible date.
