

ORDINANCE NO. 2012 - 56

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE LOWEST AND BEST BID FOR THE MASON HEIGHTS AREA DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT FROM BRUNK EXCAVATING, INC., IN THE AMOUNT OF \$449,059, AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE CONTRACT DOCUMENTS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City of Mason received on August 7, 2012 a total of 9 competitive bids for construction of the Mason Heights Area Drainage Improvements Project; and

WHEREAS, tabulation and analysis of the bids received on August 7, 2012 indicates that the lowest and best bid was provided by Brunk Excavating, Inc., in the total amount of \$449,059.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, five members thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the contract for the Mason Heights Area Drainage Improvements Project is awarded to Brunk Excavating, Inc., at the bid amount of \$449,059.

Section 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to execute contract documents with Brunk Excavating, Inc., on behalf of the City of Mason.

Section 3. That the Finance Director is authorized to make payment to Brunk Excavating, Inc., on the basis of approved payment applications, up to the contract amount of \$449,059.



That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of public health, safety, and general welfare and shall be effective immediately upon its passage. The reason for said declaration of emergency is the need to complete construction and improve drainage in the Mason Heights area at the earliest possible date.
