

ORDINANCE NO. 2013 - 76

**AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A
RECIPROCAL EASEMENT AGREEMENT RELATED TO
DOWNTOWN PARKING**


WHEREAS, the City of Mason and other downtown property owners have agreed that a shared public parking arrangement where their respective real properties would be mutually beneficial for all of said parties and their businesses located thereon and for the benefit and convenience and safety of their customers, the general public, by increasing the number of public parking spaces available and improving the ingress and egress of vehicular traffic.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, seven members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a Reciprocal Easement Agreement substantially in the form of the agreement attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein by reference.


Section 2. That this Ordinance shall be and is effective from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
