

ORDINANCE NO. 2013 - 16

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH LAKE ERIE GOLF CARS FOR THE PURCHASE OF 240 GOLF CART BATTERIES, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$25,000.00, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, quotes have been received for the purchase of 240 golf cart batteries; and

WHEREAS, based on the recommendation of Recreation Management Services, Lake Erie Golf Cars has submitted the best quote.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, six members thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Lake Erie Golf Cars for the purchase of 240 golf cart batteries at a price not to exceed \$25,000.00, where such cost shall also include shipping and disposal of the old batteries.

Section 2. That the existing golf cart batteries owned by the City of Mason are hereby declared to be obsolete, no longer necessary for any public purpose, and of no value.

Section 3. That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to pay Lake Erie Golf Cars an amount not to exceed \$25,000.00 for said golf cart batteries.

Section 4. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health, safety and general welfare of the people of this municipality, and shall take effect at the earliest date provided by law. The reason for said declaration of emergency is the need to order the replacement batteries at the earliest possible date in order to allow time for the replacements to be installed during the off season when staff time is available.
