ORDINANCE NO. 2013 - 41

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A SWIMMING POOL MANAGEMENT AND MAINTENANCE AGREEMENT WITH SWIM SAFE POOL MANAGEMENT, INC., IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$160,000.00 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City of Mason owns and operates a community swimming pool and related fixtures, amenities and equipment, and sought services to provide pool management, maintenance, operation and related services; and

WHEREAS, Swim Safe Pool Management is in the business of managing, operating and servicing community swimming pools and pool areas; and

WHEREAS, Swim Safe Pool Management has submitted an acceptable proposal to the City of Mason.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, five members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a Swimming Pool Management and Maintenance Agreement substantially in the form of the Agreement attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein by reference.

Section 2. That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to pay Swim Safe Pool Management an amount not to exceed \$160,000.00 pursuant to the terms of the Swimming Pool Management and Maintenance Agreement.

<u>Section 3.</u> That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare and shall be effective immediately upon its passage.
