ORDINANCE NO. 2013 - 59

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH GERMAIN FORD FOR THE PURCHASE OF TWO (2) 2014 FORD UTILITY POLICE INTERCEPTOR VEHICLES IN THE AMOUNT OF \$52,984.

WHEREAS, the State of Ohio has advertised and received bids for the purchase of vehicles under the state bid program; and

WHEREAS, Germain Ford was the best bidder with a bid of \$52,984 for the purchase of two (2) 2014 Ford Utility Police Interceptor vehicles for use by the city.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, seven members elected thereto concurring:

- Section 1. That the City of Mason accepts the State's vehicle specifications and agrees that Germain Ford the best bidder.
- Section 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Germain Ford for the purchase of two (2) 2014 Ford Utility Police Interceptor vehicles.
- <u>Section 3.</u> That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to pay Germain Ford the total sum of \$52,984 for said vehicles.
- Section 4. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
