ORDINANCE NO. 2014 - 12

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH JACK DOHENY SUPPLIES FOR THE PURCHASE OF ONE (1) IBAK TRUCK MOUNTED CAMERA SYSTEM IN THE AMOUNT OF \$225,316, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the State of Ohio has advertised and received bids for the purchase of IBAK truck mounted camera systems under the State Bid Program; and

WHEREAS, Jack Doheny Supplies was the best bidder with a bid of \$225,316.00 for the purchase of one (1) IBAK Truck Mounted Camera System for use by the Public Utilities Department.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, seven members elected thereto concurring:

- Section 1. That the City of Mason accepts the State's equipment specifications and agrees that Jack Doheny Supplies is the best bidder for said truck mounted camera system.
- Section 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Jack Doheny Supplies for the purchase of one (1) IBAK Truck Mounted Camera System.
- Section 3. That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to pay Jack Doheny Supplies the total sum of \$225,316.00 for said IBAK Truck Mounted Camera System.
- Section 4. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare and shall be effective immediately upon its passage. The need for said emergency is the necessity to replace existing equipment as soon as possible due to the continued unreliability and associated cost to keep the existing equipment operational.
