

ORDINANCE NO. 2014 - 21

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH C.K. SIDING & CONSTRUCTION, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$19,000.00, FOR LABOR AND MATERIAL TO REMOVE EXISTING SHINGLES, INSPECT SHEATHING, INSTALL DIMENSIONAL SHINGLES, PER PROPOSAL ON THREE STRUCTURES AT THE LOU EVES MUNICIPAL POOL, INCLUDING THE SHOWER/CONCESSION BUILDING, PUMP HOUSE, AND SHELTER

WHEREAS, the City of Mason has received a quote, in the amount of \$19,000.00, from C.K. Siding & Construction, to provide labor and material to remove the existing shingles and replace with Limited Life Time Owen Corning dimensional shingles, as per proposal for use by the City.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, six members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with C.K. Siding & Construction, to provide labor and material to remove the existing shingles and replace with Limited Life Time Owen Corning dimensional shingles, as per proposal.

Section 2. That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to pay C.K. Siding & Construction, the sum not to exceed \$19,000.00, for labor and material to remove the existing shingles and replace with Limited Life Time Owen Corning dimensional shingles, as per proposal.


Section 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare and shall be effective immediately upon its passage. The need for said emergency is the necessity to have work completed prior to pool opening thereby eliminating the demolition and construction risk to the general public.
