

ORDINANCE NO. 2014 - 89

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH VOGELPOHL FIRE EQUIPMENT INC. FOR THE PURCHASE OF A 2015 E-ONE CUSTOM PUMPER FOR THE CITY OF MASON FIRE DEPARTMENT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Fire Department has requested to replace a 1994 Seagrave engine purchased by the Mason Volunteer Fire Department with a 2015 E-One pumper at a cost of \$473,084 and

WHEREAS, the E-One pumper is listed on the state bid contract; and

WHEREAS, there will be a price increase on the state bid effective November 1, 2014.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, six members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the current 1994 engine owned by the City is hereby declared to be obsolete or unfit for municipal purposes.


Section 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Vogelphohl Fire Equipment Inc. to purchase a 2015 E-One pumper.

Section 3. That it is found to be in the best interest of the City to purchase the E-One pumper prior to the price increase effective November 1, 2014.

Section 4. That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to pay Vogelphohl Fire Equipment Inc. pursuant to the terms of said contract.


Section 5. That this Ordinance is hereby declared an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare and shall be effective immediately upon its passage. The reason for said declaration of emergency is to authorize the contract prior to the price increase effective November 1, 2014.
