RESOLUTION NO. 2014 – 4

PROCLAIMING SUPPORT OF STATE ISSUE 1 AMENDING THE OHIO CONSTITUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE ISSUANCE OF GENERAL OBLIGATIONS OF THE STATE TO FINANCE LOCAL GOVERNMENT PUBLIC INFRASTRUCTURE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS

WHEREAS, Issue 1 will ensure public health, safety and welfare, create and preserve jobs and improve the quality of life of the people and businesses in all areas of Ohio by improving local government public infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, Issue 1 will authorize the State of Ohio to issue up to \$1.875 billion in bonds to pay for or help local governments pay for the cost of public infrastructure capital improvements of local governments, including roads and bridges, wastewater treatment systems, water supply systems, solid waste disposal facilities, storm water and sanitary collection, storage and treatment facilities; and

WHEREAS, Issue 1 will continue a 27-year old proven affordable and successful program to help local governments afford vital infrastructure improvements to maintain our quality of life.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, six members elected thereto concurring:

<u>Section 1.</u> That said investment will improve the quality of life for all Ohioans.

Section 2. That the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, supports and endorses the passage of State Issue 1.

<u>Section 3.</u> That the Clerk is hereby directed to certify a copy of this Resolution to the Ohio Public Works Commission.

Section 4. That this Resolution shall be in force and become effective from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
