ORDINANCE NO. 2015 - 58

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH WC STOREY FOR ALL LABOR AND MATERIALS NECESSARY TO PROVIDE FUELING STATION PUMPS, TANKS, AND DISPENSING EQUIPMENT TO A NEW FUEL DEPOT AT THE MASON SERVICE CENTER IN THE AMOUNT OF \$136,400 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, bids were solicited for the pumps, tanks, and dispensing equipment for a new fuel depot at the Mason Service Center; and

WHEREAS, WC Storey was the best bidder with a bid of \$136,400 for the materials and labor necessary to provide pumps, tanks, and dispensing equipment to the fuel depot;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, seven members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with WC Storey for the materials and labor necessary to provide pumps, tanks, dispensing equipment to a fuel depot at the Mason Service Center.

<u>Section 2.</u> That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to pay WC Storey the total sum of \$136,400 for said service.

Section 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare and shall be effective immediately upon its passage. The need for said emergency is the necessity to provide and install the equipment as soon as possible to allow for vehicle maintenance operations to begin at the new service center.
