

ORDINANCE NO. 2015 - 66

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH SHIVER SECURITY SYSTEMS FOR ALL LABOR AND MATERIALS NECESSARY TO PROVIDE ACCESS AND CAMERA SECURITY SYSTEM AT THE MASON SERVICE CENTER IN THE AMOUNT OF \$45,000 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, bids were solicited for the access and camera security system for the Mason Service Center; and

WHEREAS, Shiver Security Systems was the best bidder with a bid of \$45,000 for the materials and labor necessary to provide security access and cameras at the Service Center;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, seven members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Shiver Security Systems for the materials and labor necessary to provide security access and cameras at the Mason Service Center.

Section 2. That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to pay Shiver Security Systems the total sum of \$45,000 for said service.



That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare and shall be effective immediately upon its passage. The need for said emergency is the necessity to provide and install the equipment as soon as possible to allow for vehicle maintenance operations to begin at the new service center.
