

**RESOLUTION 2015 - 2**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MASON, OHIO, AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A REQUEST TO THE UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE FOR THE MODIFICATION OF ZIP CODE BOUNDARIES**

WHEREAS, the primary ZIP Code serving the City of Mason's residents and businesses is 45040; and

WHEREAS, the corporate boundaries of Mason also encompass three other ZIP Codes, including 45036 (Lebanon) to the north, 45034 (Kings Mills) to the east, and 45039 (Maineville) to the southeast; and

WHEREAS, Mason community and corporate citizens who do not reside in the 45040, are adversely affected by not sharing the primary ZIP Code of the City; and

WHEREAS, the City of Mason has received requests from community and corporate citizens to realign the postal boundaries to match the municipal boundary; and

WHEREAS, the realignment will correct the lack of municipal identity for the area of the City of Mason impacted by the change, and eliminate confusion for visitors and deliveries to businesses; and

WHEREAS, the health, safety and comfort of this community will be enhanced by the requested realignment.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, six members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That, the City of Mason City Council strongly supports the realignment of the 45040 ZIP Code boundary in order to unify the area under the primary ZIP Code of the City.

Section 2. That, the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, directs staff to submit a letter to the United States Postal Service District Manager to facilitate this request.

Section 3. That this Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
