ORDINANCE 2016 - 11

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH RYAN REMODELING IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$50,000 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City has discovered that certain structural deficiencies exist with the Pro Shop at the City-owned golf course; and

WHEREAS, due to the exigent circumstances and the need to make emergency structural repairs, the City Manager has authorized certain work to begin; and

WHEREAS, Ryan Remodeling has submitted a proposal to provide the materials and labor necessary to begin the emergency structural repairs and other related remodeling.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, seven members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Ryan Remodeling for the materials and labor necessary to provide emergency structural repairs and other remodeling to the Pro Shop at the City-owned golf course.

<u>Section 2.</u> That City Council hereby affirms the emergency nature of the necessary repairs and ratifies the City Manager's determination to begin certain emergency repair work prior to the adoption of this Ordinance.

Section 3. That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to pay Ryan Remodeling the not to exceed amount of \$50,000 for said work.

Section 4. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare and shall be effective immediately upon its passage. The need for said emergency is the necessity to provide for emergency structural repairs at the earliest possible date in order to address the structural deficiencies discovered in the Pro Shop.
