ORDINANCE 2016 - 76

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH FORD DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION, FOR THE AMBLESIDE OFFSITE IMPROVEMENT PROJECT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,878,045

WHEREAS, Resolution 2016-2 Declared the Necessity of Improving Certain Property by Constructing Public Infrastructure Improvements as request by the property owner of Ambleside Meadows; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 2016-25 Determined Need to Proceed with Certain Public Infrastructure Improvements; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 2016-26 Levies a Special Assessment to Pay for the Cost of Improving Certain Property by Construction of Public Infrastructure Improvements and Financing the Expenses in Connection with the Improvements; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 2016-27 Delegates Authority to Make Declaration of Official Intent to Reimbursements of Temporary Advances for Capital Improvements for Road and Utility Improvements from Subsequent Borrowings; and

WHEREAS, bids were received for the Ambleside Offsite Improvement Project; and

WHEREAS, Ford Development Corporation was the lowest and best bidder with a total bid of \$1,878,045 for the Ambleside Offsite Improvement Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio five members elected thereto concurring:

- <u>Section 1.</u> That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Ford Development Corporation, for Ambleside Offsite Improvement Project according to the specifications set forth by the City.
- Section 2. That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to pay Ford Development Corporation, an amount not to exceed \$1,878,045 for the Ambleside Offsite Improvement Project.
- Section 3. That the General Capital Improvement Fund will advance up to \$1,900,000 to Ambleside Meadows Improvement Fund for fiscal years 2016 and 2017 to be reimbursed from proceeds of subsequent financing for the special assessment.
- Section 4. That \$1,900,000 become and are hereby set aside and appropriated from the Ambleside Meadows Improvement Fund for fiscal year ending December 31, 2016 for the payments as authorized in this ordinance.

<u>Section 5.</u> That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
