

ORDINANCE 2016 - 122

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH BROWNING DAY MULLINS AND DIERDORF FOR GOLF CENTER MASTER PLANNING SERVICES IN THE AMOUNT OF \$64,500

WHEREAS, the Grizzly golf course, Bruin golf course, golf center facilities, and the Lindner Family Tennis Center consist of over 264 acres strategically located along the I-71 corridor; and

WHEREAS, the City of Mason has sought proposals for certain master planning services for the Golf Center; and

WHEREAS, Browning Day Mullins and Dierdorf have submitted a proposal for a professional master planning services that is acceptable to the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, seven members thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a professional services agreement consistent with the proposal from Browning Day Mullins and Dierdorf substantially in the form of that attached hereto as Exhibit "A" incorporated herein by reference.

Section 2. That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to pay Browning Day Mullins and Dierdorf pursuant to the terms of said professional services agreement.

Section 3. That this Ordinance shall be effective from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
