

RESOLUTION 2016-11

PROCLAIMING MAY AS MENTAL HEALTH AWARENESS MONTH

WHEREAS, the City of Mason has demonstrated a commitment to nurturing a Culture of Wellness and mental health as a critical part of overall wellness; and

WHEREAS, cultivating a biohealth cluster through strategic partnerships with innovative companies in the mental health sector is a key City of Mason economic development strategy; and

WHEREAS, one in five adults and one in ten children will experience a mental health disorder in a given year and the scientific research and innovative discoveries happening in Mason companies are producing tremendous breakthroughs in the understanding of mental wellness, resulting in more precise treatments and are changing outcomes; and

WHEREAS, local innovation partner Assurex Health is a precision medicine company that specializes in pharmacogenomics within mental wellness and is dedicated to helping healthcare providers help individuals find the most effective medication so they can live active, fulfilling lives; and

WHEREAS, Assurex Health reached a Mental Wellness Milestone: over 300,000 patients have been tested with GeneSight fostering a road to mental wellness; and

WHEREAS, local innovation partner Lindner Center of HOPE advocates for mental health and wellness as a core focus for every individual in the community and has served more than 27,000 patients since opening; and

WHEREAS, The Lindner Center of HOPE is an internationally recognized research institution providing patient-centered, scientifically-advanced care for individuals suffering with mental illness; and

WHEREAS, Mental Health America began observing “May is Mental Health Month” in 1949 to raise awareness of mental health conditions and mental wellness for all.


NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, five members elected thereto concurring:
