

ORDINANCE 2017 – 154

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH PROPUMP & CONTROLS, INC. FOR AN IRRIGATION PUMP CONTROL SYSTEM AND RELATED EQUIPMENT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City of Mason has received quotes for replacement of the irrigation pump control system at The Golf Center;

WHEREAS, the quote from ProPump & Controls, Inc. for an amount not to exceed \$53,560; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 133.05 of the Mason Codified Ordinances, competitive bidding is not required for such services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, seven members thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the contract for the irrigation pump control system is authorized for ProPump & Controls, Inc. for \$53,560.

Section 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to execute contract documents with ProPump & Controls, Inc. on behalf of the City of Mason.

Section 3. That the Finance Director is authorized to make payment to ProPump & Controls, Inc. on the basis of approved payment applications, up to the contract amount of \$53,560.

Section 4. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare and shall be effective immediately upon its adoption. The reason for said declaration of emergency is the need to complete the replacement of the pump panel before irrigation is needed to prevent damage to the golf course.
