

ORDINANCE 2017 – 155

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH SMITH HUGHES FOR REPAIR OF EQUIPMENT AT THE WATER RECLAMATION PLANT IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$63,000 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City of Mason has discovered certain repairs are necessary in the hot oil boiler at the Water Reclamation Plant; and

WHEREAS, Smith Hughes has provided a proposal for such repair at an amount not to exceed of \$63,000.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, seven members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the City of Mason accepts the not to exceed price of \$63,000.00 from Smith Hughes.

Section 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to execute contract documents with Smith Hughes for the repair of the hot oil boiler at the Water Reclamation Plant on behalf of the City of Mason, pursuant to the proposal attached hereto as Exhibit A.

Section 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare and shall be effective immediately upon its adoption. The reason for said declaration of emergency is the need to complete the repairs at the earliest possible date to avoid interruption of services at the Water Reclamation Plant.
