

ORDINANCE 2017 - 9

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH STAUFFER SITE SERVICES, LLC FOR THE MARIVAL/BROADVIEW STREAM RESTORATION PROJECT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$226,415 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, bids were received for the Marival/Broadview Stream Restoration Project; and

WHEREAS, Stauffer Site Services, LLC, was the lowest and best bidder with a total bid of \$226,415 for the Marival/Broadview Stream Restoration Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, six members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the total bid of Stauffer Site Services, LLC, in the amount of \$226,415, is hereby accepted as the lowest and best bid for the Marival/Broadview Stream Restoration Project.

Section 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Stauffer Site Services, LLC, for the Marival/Broadview Stream Restoration Project according to the specifications set forth by the City.

Section 3. That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to pay Stauffer Site Services, LLC, an amount not to exceed \$226,415 for the Marival/Broadview Stream Restoration Project.

Section 4. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare and shall be effective immediately upon its passage. The need for said emergency is the necessity to complete work in accordance to the technical specifications for native plantings.
