ORDINANCE 2017 – 19

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH LUMENATE FOR THE PURCHASE OF NETWORK INFRASTRUCTURE EQUIPMENT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$190,000

WHEREAS, the Federal Government has advertised and received bids for the purchase of computer technology and related infrastructure equipment; and

WHEREAS, State and Local Governments are permitted to purchase items negotiated through this process through the Cooperative Purchasing Program; and

WHEREAS, Lumenate is equal to or less than the best bidder with a price of \$190,000 for the purchase of 2 backup servers, 2 replication servers, 4 servers to function as Virtual hosts, one SAN (Storage attached network device), additional storage for existing city SAN, and backup/disaster recovery software with necessary licensing.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, seven members elected thereto concurring:

<u>Section 1.</u> That the City of Mason accepts the Federal Government's specifications for network infrastructure equipment and agrees that Lumenate is equal to or less than the best bidder.

<u>Section 2.</u> That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Lumenate for the purchase of 2 backup servers, 2 replication servers, 4 servers to function as Virtual hosts, one SAN (Storage attached network device), additional storage for existing city SAN, and backup/disaster recovery software with necessary licensing.

<u>Section 3.</u> That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to pay Lumenate the sum of \$190,000 for said equipment.

<u>Section 4.</u> That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
